Port Ordinance No. 3439, as amended, establishes rates and charges that apply to the Port's provision of electric power to any person or entity at any facility within the Port Area (as defined by the Charter of the City of Oakland), in addition to the portion of the Port Area within which exist facilities for the transshipment of cargo from, to and between domestic carriers and/or carriers engaged in coastwide, inter-coastal, or foreign trade.</p>	-	(*) 11105
<p style="text-align: center;">FRESH WATER SERVICE RATES</p> <p>Fresh water supplied by the East Bay Municipal Utility District will be assessed charges in accordance with that utility's rate structure. Said rates are subject to change without notification from the Port. Water delivered through pipelines of the Port with billing thereof performed by the Port will also be assessed a service charge of fifteen percent (15%) of the cost of such water (see Note) - Wharfage for water supplied will also be assessed in accordance with Item 07220.</p> <p>Note: When service charge is assessed, a minimum of \$5.00; and, a maximum of \$26.00 for each billing period (30 calendar days) or fraction thereof will apply. Service charges will be billed by and accrue to the Port.</p>		11110

SECTION XI: MISCELLANEOUS CHARGES

ORDINANCE

If any section subsection, item, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Board of Port Commissioners of the City of Oakland hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance, and each section, subsection, item, sentence, clause and phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or sole other sections, subsections, items, sentences, clauses or phrases be declared, invalid or unconstitutional.

The provisions of Port Ordinance No. 964 and all ordinances amendatory thereof, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed and replaced by the provisions of this ordinance; provided, however, that if for any reason all or any part of the provisions of Port of Oakland Tariff No. 2A are suspended and not permitted to go into effect, then the corresponding items and provisions of Port of Oakland Tariff No. 2 shall remain in effect and apply until such time as the suspended portions of Port of Oakland Tariff No. 2A become effective and provided further that any references to Port of Oakland Tariff No. 2 contained in existing Port agreements or other documents shall be deemed to include this Port of Oakland Tariff No. 2A as the successor and replacement to said Tariff No. 2.
